School Lunches

Please note that Taylor Shaw have increased the price of school lunches to £2.05 per day from September. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 still receive a free dinner paid for by the government. From Year 3 onwards they are to pay for at £10.25 per week. Please ensure dinners are paid for in advance as school cannot allow you to get into arrears.
