Attendance

In order to maximise their learning then children need to be in school every day. This year we are awarding termly certificates and gift vouchers at the end of the year for 100% all year.

Please try to arrange medical appointments after school. If this is not possible then the afternoon is better after the children are registered. If children are not present at the time of registration in the morning or the afternoon then they are recorded as being late, absent or medical.

The schools current attendance remains at 97.3% which is line with the National target of 96%. The attendance is monitored regularly and we are expected to notify you when your child's attendance falls below 90%. Attendance below 90% is considered to "Persistent Absence" and therefore triggers involvement from the Local Authority. Please note if you take your child out of school for a holiday for 7 school days without authorisation then you are likely to receive a fine. This is £60 per parent, per child. The fine is issued by the Local Authority and is paid to them. Please see the attendance policy on the website for further clarification.

We still require holiday forms to be completed so we know where the children are, even though holidays will be unauthorised unless there is sufficient evidence of exceptional circumstances.

Breakfast Club/ After School Club- Little Darlings

There are spaces in Breakfast Club should you require a regular place at the reduced price of £3.00 per day. After School also has places which can be used as required at £7.00 per session per child. Ad-hoc sessions can be arranged in agreement with Nicola Coulthard once children are registered.

Please can you telephone the school when your child is absent as we need to make sure that the children are safe and where they should be. (01388 816230) Please let us know of any changes in mobile numbers or **contact details**. Can you please make sure that you do not park in the staff carpark unless you need to use the disabled space. Can we also remind you that the equipment on the playground should not be used before and after school.
