School Council


The school council will be meeting our Governors on Friday 15th March to share with them the work they have been doing in school and what their plans are for the rest of the year.

Grants

Sadly we are in a situation where school budgets are extremely tight. We have successfully secured a £5000 grant from the Healthy Schools Capital Fund towards some portable floodlights for our MUGA. We are also hopeful that we are going to receive funding for a Brass music performance in the summer. We are also sourcing grants from Spennymoor AAP and from Taylor Shaw towards gardening resources.
